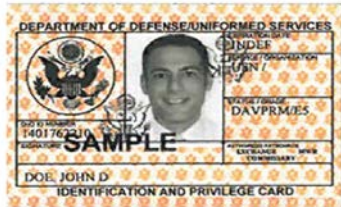
Alaska State Driver's License or Alaska State ID Card (valid with or without "V" on the Flag image)

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs has renewed a transportation grant to the State of Alaska Department of Military & Veterans Affairs, and the State has advised the Inter-Island Ferry Authority that the IFA has been accepted into the Veteran Federal Transportation Grant Program again this year!

Effective October 1, 2017, the IFA is authorized to issue both Passenger and Vehicle ticketing to Veterans when traveling in conjunction with healthcare needs.

Present your current Alaska Driver License or ID Card with the VA endorsement, Armed Forces of the United States ID Card {Retiree}, 100% Disabled Veterans (DAV) or VA Healthcare Card to qualify for this no-cost to Veterans program. Examples of these IDs are shown here. Escorts will be required to get prior authorization to travel from Forrest Powell.
